November 1, Shamrock Springs Elementary School (747 W. 161st St., Westfield), 7 – 9 pm: Susan Brooks and Dee Thornton for US Congressional District 5. This forum will be held in partnership with the Indianapolis League. The moderator will be Rhea Cain.
